Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 1154

Modifies provisions of law related to declarations of ground water quality concern areas and ground water management areas.

Work Session

SB 427

Prohibits certain proposed changes related to the appropriation or use of water that will result in the diminishment of streamflow.

SB 1153

Directs the Water Resources Department to consider whether certain water right transfers will result in a loss of in-stream habitat for sensitive, threatened or endangered aquatic species in stream reaches not protected by an existing water right or contribute to water quality impairment in water quality limited streams.

SB 83 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Makes changes related to building code standards for wildfire hazard mitigation.

SB 85 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Fire Marshal to establish a neighborhood protection cooperative grant program.

SB 1019

Increases the maximum fee for activating a brand.

SB 147

Requires the State Forester to study the management of the Elliott State Forest.

April 8, 2025

SB 74

Requires the Department of State Lands to study determinations of navigability on Oregon waterways.

Possible Work Session

SB 1076

Directs the State Department of Agriculture to impose certain fees for licenses and license renewals for animal rescue entities.
