HB 3910 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/6/2025 MEETING: Expands the justifications for a domestic water supply district to exercise the powers of a sanitary district.

HB 3372 A

Permits certain exempt ground water users to withdraw up to 3,000 gallons of water per day for watering any lawn or noncommercial or commercial garden that does not exceed one-half acre.

HB3342 A

> CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/6/2025 MEETING: Modifies provisions of law related to the regulation and administration of water rights in this state.

3932 A

Prohibits a person from taking a beaver on waters or watersheds that are classified in a certain manner or on public land that is within the watersheds or within 200 feet of the ordinary high water mark of the waters.
