Public Hearing

SB 437

Expands the application of certain statutes requiring publication in a newspaper to allow publication in online news publications.

SB 1006

Directs all state agencies, statewide elected officials and other entities to seek legislative changes only through legislative measures requested and introduced by members and committees of the Legislative Assembly.

SB 370

Directs the Legislative Policy and Research Director to distribute to interim committees of Legislative Assembly a summary of administrative rules that have been adopted in the previous two years that are relevant to the subject of the interim committee.

SB 483

Requires the Legislative Policy and Research Director to study methods for legislative oversight of administrative rules.

SB 224

Prohibits the Secretary of State from publishing the residence address of certain individuals who are affiliated with a candidate's principal campaign committee on the electronic filing system maintained by the secretary.
