Work Session

SB 1014

Requires the Secretary of State to allow to be included in the translated version of each state voters' pamphlet that is made available on the website of the secretary or of a county the translations of a party's statement of arguments for the success of its principles and election of its candidates.

Public Hearing

SJM 10

Urges the President of the United States, the Executive Director of the Maritime Administration of the United States Department of Transportation and the Congress of the United States to purchase the SS United States from Okaloosa County, Florida, designate it as a National Historic Landmark, restore it to its full working condition and name it the official flagship of our nation.

HB 2922 A

Provides that State Parks and Recreation Department employees whose job classification is a park manager or a park ranger are eligible to request that records kept by the Department of Transportation contain the employer's address instead of the employee's home address.

SB 1180

Requires the Secretary of State to submit to the Legislative Assembly, by November 1 of each odd-numbered year, a list of each prospective statewide initiative petition that has been filed for the next general election.

Recognizes the important role of Aurora State Airport in the State of Oregon's emergency preparedness and response efforts.
