#### **Work Session**

SB 44

Requires the Secretary of State to study elections.

HB 2269 A

Authorizes the Oregon State Capitol Foundation voting directors to appoint all voting directors who are not appointed by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SB 243 A

Prohibits a gun dealer from transferring a firearm or unfinished frame or receiver until 72 hours have elapsed from the time the gun dealer requested a criminal background check, and the gun dealer has received the background check approval number from the Department of State Police.

HB 2930

Applies conflict of interest provisions to members of the household of public officials.

HB 2932

Provides an exception to the prohibition against a public official using official position or office for financial gain or avoidance of financial detriment.
