Increases fees charged by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 3643

Designates October 9 of each year as Oregon Youth Suicide Awareness Day.

Work Session

SJM 10

Urges the President of the United States, the Executive Director of the Maritime Administration of the United States Department of Transportation and the Congress of the United States to purchase the SS United States from Okaloosa County, Florida, designate it as a National Historic Landmark, restore it to its full working condition and name it the official flagship of our nation.

SCR 28

In memoriam: Charles Benjamin "Chuck" Mawhinney, 1949-2024.

HB 2930

Applies conflict of interest provisions to members of the household of public officials.

HB 2932

Provides an exception to the prohibition against a public official using official position or office for financial gain or avoidance of financial detriment.

SB 1166

Requires transportation network companies to pay minimum compensation rates to drivers.

SB 1180

Requires the Secretary of State to submit to the Legislative Assembly, by November 1 of each odd-numbered year, a list of each prospective statewide initiative petition that has been filed for the next general election.

Note change: SB 836, HB 3643, HB 2930, HB 2932, SB 1166, and SB 1180 added.
