SB 602 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes the Nonprofit Organization Advisory Council within the Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

SR 2

Recognizes the important role of Aurora State Airport in the State of Oregon's emergency preparedness and response efforts.

SB 836 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Increases fees charged by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

SB 1166

Requires transportation network companies to pay minimum compensation rates to drivers.

Public Hearing

SB 1077

Requires the Public Records Advisory Council to study public records.

HB 3569 A

Requires an agency that appoints a rules advisory committee with regard to rules implementing legislation to invite certain legislators to participate on the committee as nonvoting members.

SB 1060 A

Requires a hospital to establish, update and make public a list of standard charges that lists the regular rates or prices established by the hospital for items or services and shoppable services offered or provided by the hospital.
