SB 686 A

Requires online platforms to pay moneys to digital journalism providers and the Oregon Civic Information Consortium.

SB 1051

Transfers the authority to appoint a State Forester from the State Board of Forestry to the Governor, subject to Senate confirmation.

HB 3582 A

Modifies the qualifications for certain statutes of limitations for civil actions based on allowing, permitting or encouraging child abuse and sexual assault.

HB 3953 A

Allows an applicant for a public charter school that is a federally recognized Indian tribe in this state to directly apply to the State Board of Education for sponsorship.

Public Hearing

SB 1173

Provides that a health care facility is not a manufacturer, distributor, seller or lessor of a product for purposes of a product liability civil action if the health care facility was not involved in the design or manufacture of the product.
