Public Hearing

SB 1193

Permits a post-secondary institution of education to provide compensation to a student athlete for use of the student athlete's name, image, likeness or athletic reputation.

HB 2658

Prohibits cities or counties from conditioning a permit or zoning change on the development of an improvement project that has already been financed, planned or approved.

HB 3410 A

Amends portions of an Act that restricts management services organizations from owning a majority interest in professional medical entities and that prohibits noncompetition agreements, nondisparagement agreements and nondisclosure agreements between medical licensees and other persons.

HB 3908

Increases the party registration requirement to be a major political party in this state from five percent to 10 percent.

Work Session

HB 3474

Requires the Secretary of State to study changes to the United States Postal Service.

HB 3865 B

Prohibits as an unlawful practice under the Unlawful Trade Practices Act a person's initiating a telephone solicitation outside specified hours or more than three separate times within a 24-hour period, misrepresenting or falsifying the person's identity, the purpose of the call or the location from which the person is calling or failing to make required disclosures or inquiries during the call.

Note change: SB 1193 and HB 3865 B added.
