#### **Public Hearing**

SB 225

Exempts from state income tax up to \$17,500 in retirement pay or pension received for service in the Armed Forces of the United States for a taxpayer who is receiving retirement pay or pension for service in the Armed Forces of the United States and who has not attained 63 years of age before the close of the taxable year for which a return is filed.

SB 505

Directs the Oregon Department of Emergency Management to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to certain counties to fund emergency preparedness coordinators.

SB 596

Provides that a person eligible for a veterans' recognition registration plate may request a waiver of the surcharge imposed for the plate.

The following bills are scheduled solely for the purpose of moving them back to the Senate President's desk for referral to another committee.
