SB 668

Expands tuition benefits available to disabled veterans to permit veterans who are Oregon residents and are 80 percent or more disabled, and the spouse and child of disabled veterans, to have tuition waived for enrollment in a vocational program or an associate degree, baccalaureate degree or master's degree program at community colleges, public universities and the Oregon Health and Science University.

SB 798

Provides out-of-state members of the Oregon National Guard with in-state tuition and other higher education benefits.

SB 806

Allows the Civil Air Patrol to use Oregon National Guard armories and facilities for official business at no cost.

SB 947

Modifies terminology by changing statutory references to "militia" to "national guard. SB 658

Provides t

Provides that, when an interview is an element of the process of selecting a candidate for a civil service position from an eligibility list, the public employer must interview each veteran applicant who meets the qualifications for the position and shows transferable skills if the duties of the position are performed by only one person within the public employer's organization.
