SB 459

Removes the requirement that a licensee member of the Oregon Board of Maritime Pilots be a resident of this state.

SB 393

Requires the Oregon Department of Emergency Management to study solar events.

SB 947

Modifies terminology by changing statutory references to "militia" to "national guard.

SB 1011

Allows a federally recognized Indian tribe located in this state to submit a request to the Governor for retrocession of Public Law 280 jurisdiction.

HB 2386

Provides the Department of Veterans' Affairs with authority to adopt rules to implement the laws concerning the unclaimed remains of veterans, veterans' spouses and dependents and survivors of veterans.

HB 2581

Expands the duties of the State Resilience Officer.
