SB 947

Modifies terminology by changing statutory references to "militia" to "national guard.

SB 2

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Salvage Chief (LSM380) Foundation for the purpose of repairing and upgrading a salvage vessel.

Public Hearing

HB 3175

Removes the cap on fees a county may charge to fund the county's activities related to public land survey corners.

SB 596

Provides that a person eligible for a veterans' recognition registration plate may request a waiver of the surcharge imposed for the plate.
