Number of Oregonians who die early because of diesel pollution each year. What diesel pollution exposure costs Oregonians annually. Diesel exhaust contains 40 cancercausing substances.

Dirty Diesel: A Statewide Problem



Feasible and Reasonable

- Diesel Trucks will still be sold in 2050, never a 100% mandate
- 45% of Oregon's trucks are electrifiable today based on range
 - 200 electric school buses are either on our roads or soon to be
- Most manufacturers are already compliant for MY 2025
- Cost Parity: long term savings
