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# 2024 Emergency Declarations

- **Severe Rainstorm:** Coos, Curry, Douglas, Jackson, and Tillamook Counties (January)
- **Severe Winter Storm:** Statewide (January)
- **Fentanyl:** Multnomah County (January)
- **Drought:** Jefferson County (June), Lake County (September), Wallowa County (October), Harney County (November)
- **Extreme Heat:** Statewide (July)
- **Tsunami:** Near miss (December)



# Disaster Resilience Duties

- Continuity of Operations Planning.

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- Wildfire recovery.

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- **Resilience advisors:** Oregon Seismic Safety Advisory Committee, Emergency Preparedness Advisory Council, Cybersecurity Council.

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- Statewide resilience plan.
