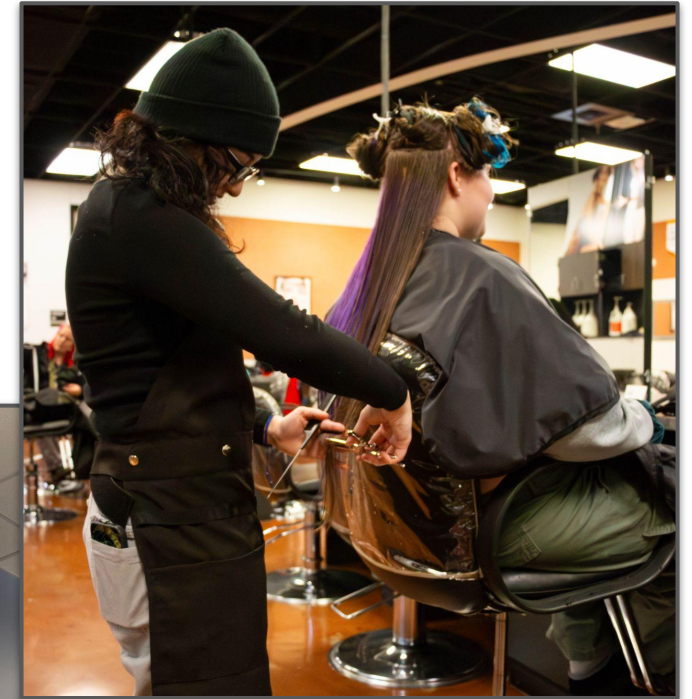

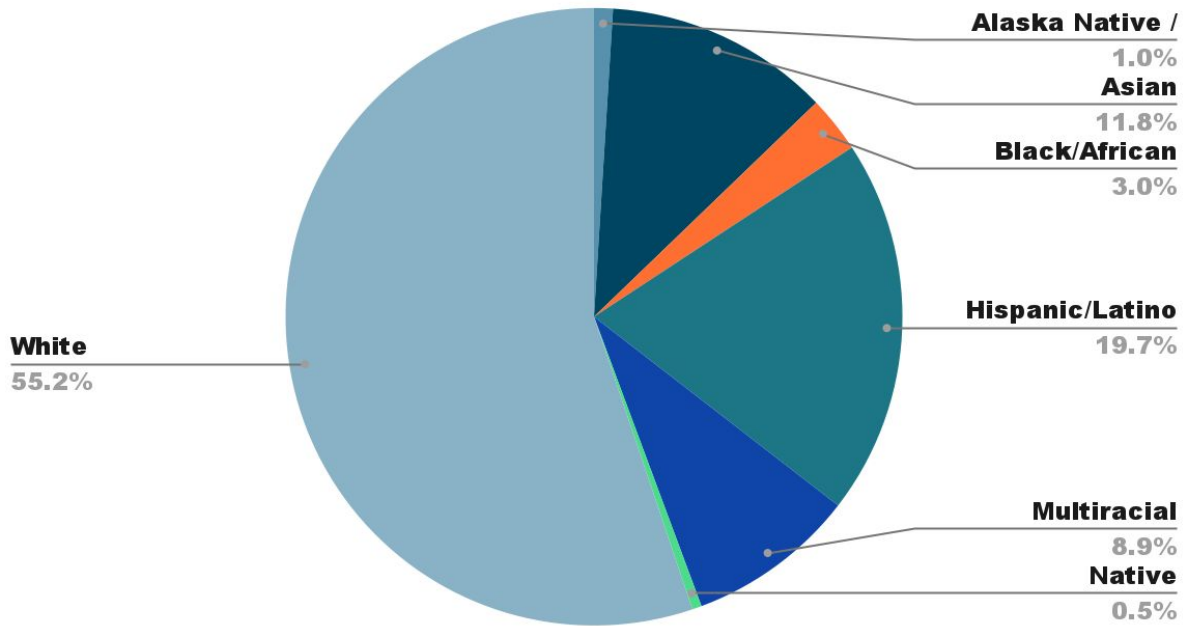

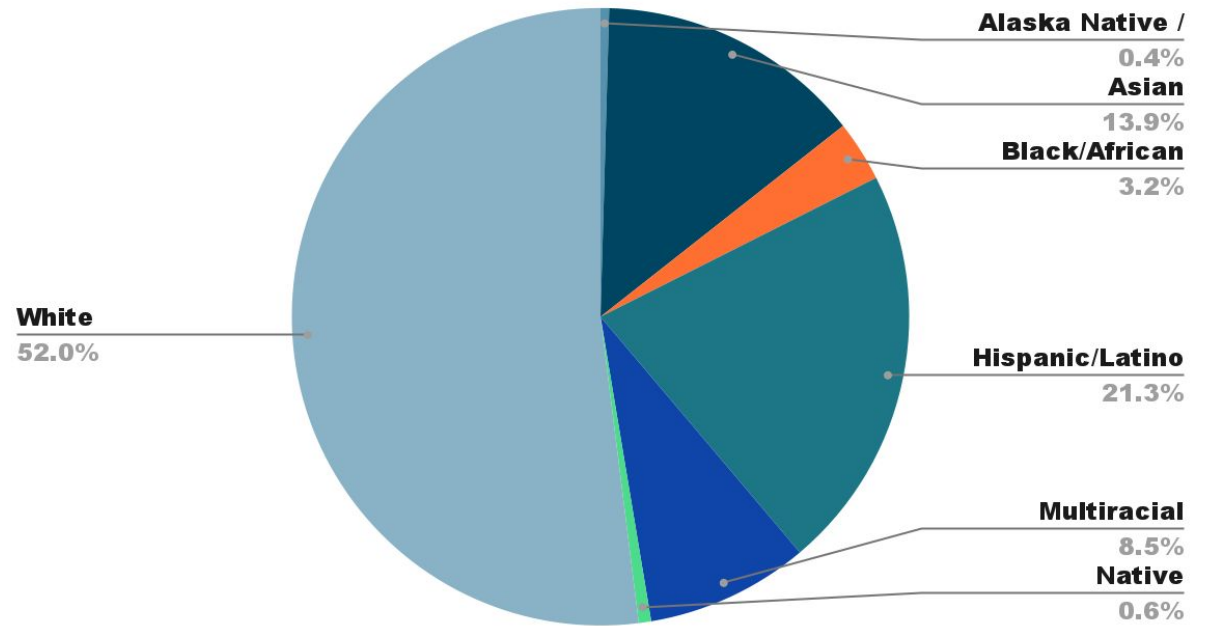


Who Attends Sabin-Schellenberg?

District Wide Demographics



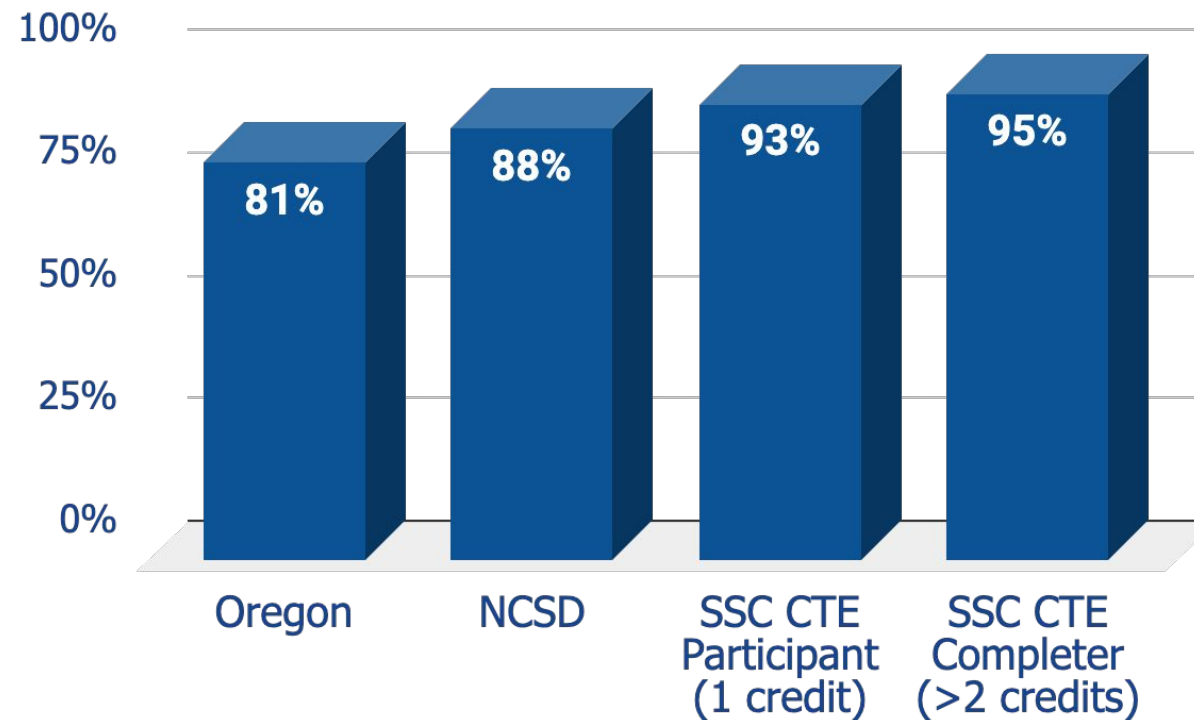
SSC Student Demographics

Industry Recognized Credentials:

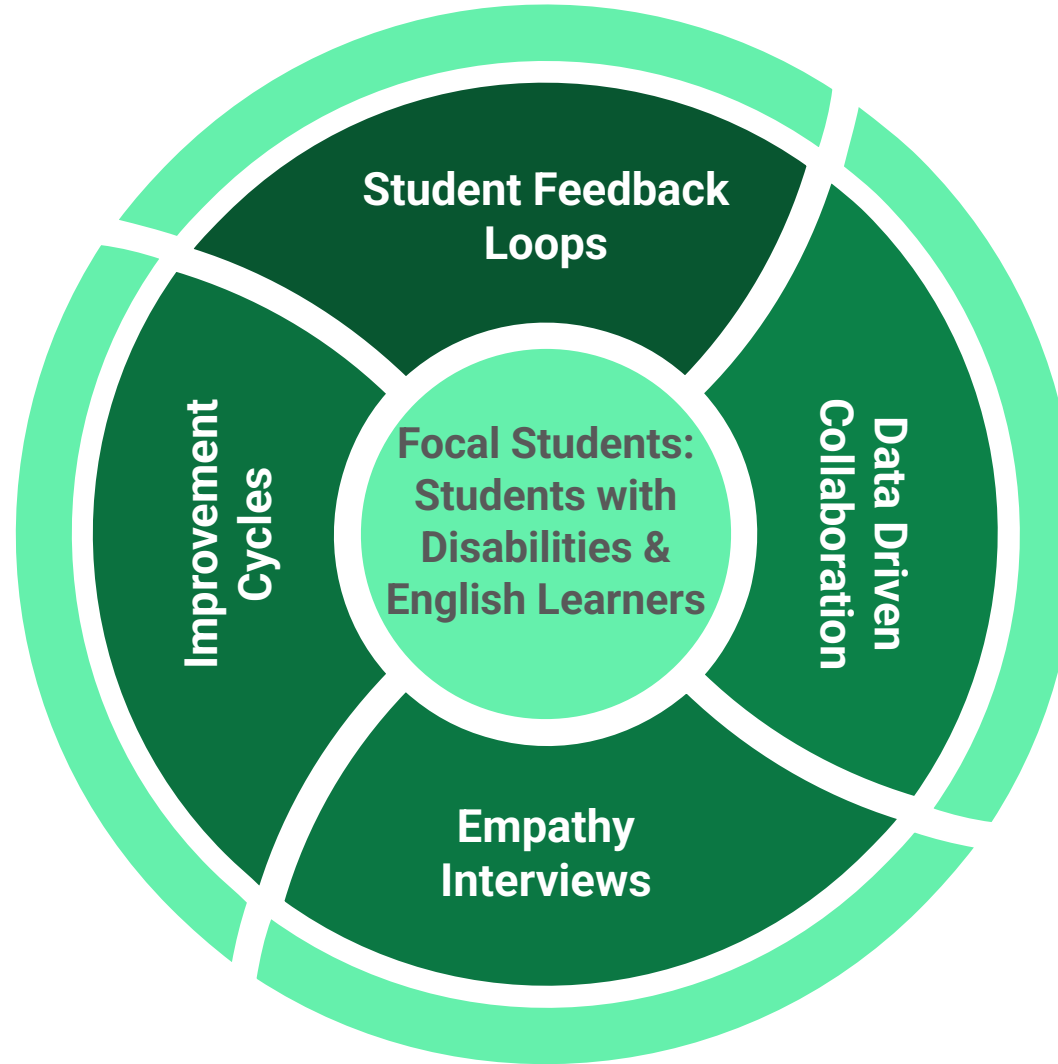
- ★ 455 Credentials awarded last year

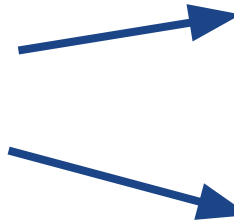


Promoting Success for Students

Baseline

Students receiving Special Education or English Language Supports

- ★ Received 9% less A's and B's
- ★ Received 6% more F's



Additional Support Provided

Students receiving Special Education Supports

- ★ 15% less A's and B's
- ★ 2% more F's

Students Receiving English Language Supports

- ★ 3% less A's and B's
- ★ Less than 2% more F's
