

- I 950-60s: Oregon Fair Housing Laws & Federal Civil Rights Act

- I 960-70s: Expanded Jurisdiction
- 1980-90s: Savings & Loan Crisis, Property Manager License Instituted, Agency Reorganization, Appraisers Separated
- 2000-10s: Great Recession, Economic Recovery
- 2020s: Remote Work, Rising Prices New Licensee Peak










HB 4058














2025-2027 – Other Funds
