HEALTH CARE

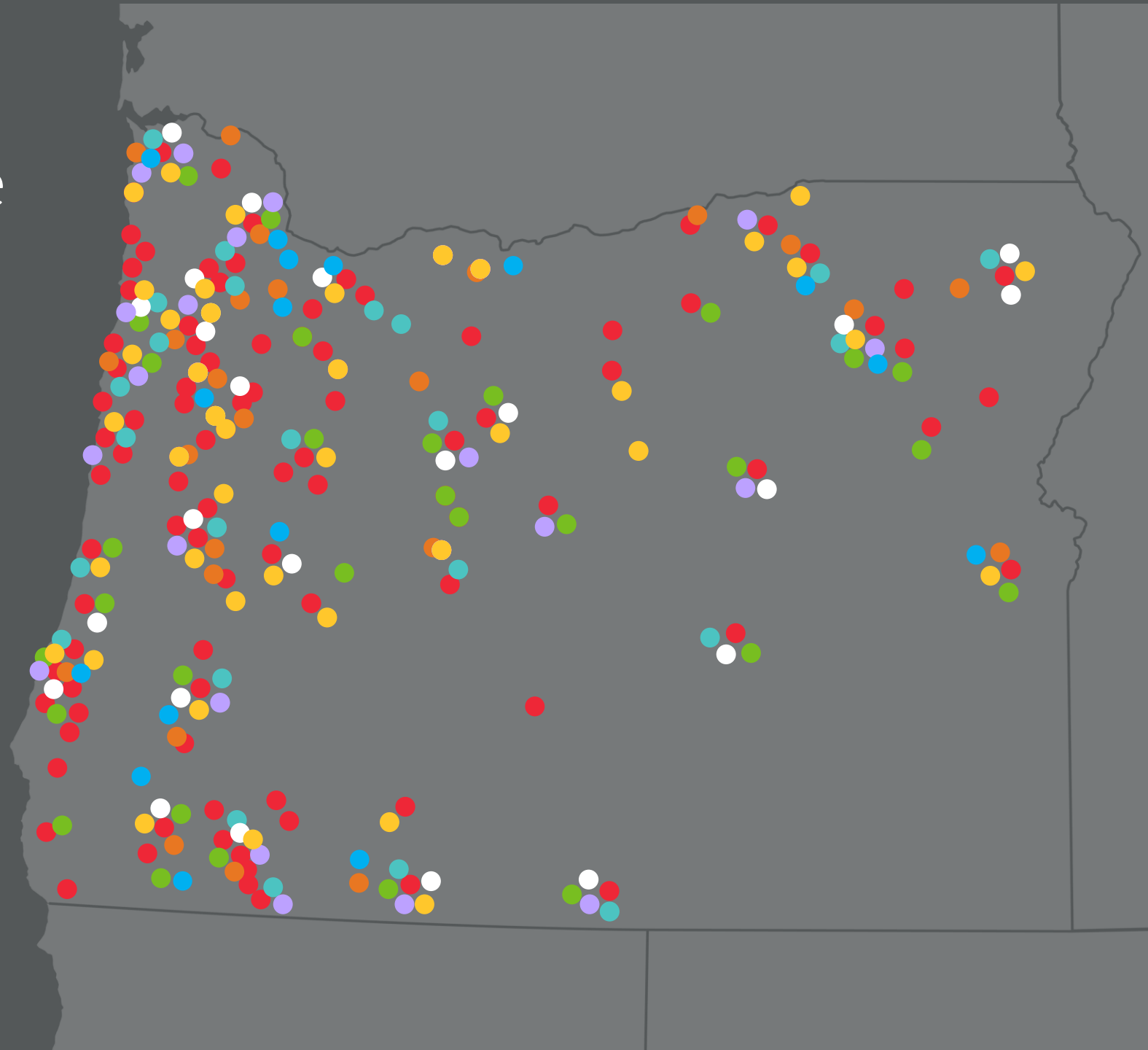
- **#1 hospital in Oregon.**
- More than one million patient visits – nearly 90% from Oregon.
- Over half of patient visits are those covered by a public payer or are uninsured.
- Provides the most complex and acute care in Oregon with nearly half of inpatient visits from outside of Portland.

RESEARCH

- **\$580 million** in grants and funding in FY24.
- 86 invention disclosures FY23.
- Largest recipient of NIH funding in Oregon.
- Home to the only Comprehensive Cancer Center between Seattle and San Francisco.
