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# Light Vehicle Tax Comparison Study

- Analysis looks at costs across multiple states from the perspective if Oregon were to adopt another state's vehicle taxing programs
- Specifically estimates:
  - Fuels Taxes (state and local)
  - Registration fees
  - Ad Valorem Taxes (vehicle property tax)
  - Vehicle Sales Taxes
  - Title and related fees
- Assumes average light vehicle information, Oregon specific where possible

# **Vehicle Taxes in Oregon**

- The average vehicle in Oregon pays about **3.1 cents per mile** in state and local vehicles taxes.
- That equates to **\$294 per year** for a vehicle that drives the average number of miles (9,600).
- Oregon currently has the lowest overall taxes, with Montana a close 2nd
