WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure forbids the selling, purchase, or claiming for compensation of a winning lottery ticket or a share of a winning lottery ticket prize that the Oregon State Lottery Commission does not allow a lottery game retailer to pay. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3115 forbids the selling, purchase, or claiming for compensation of a winning lottery ticket or a share of a winning lottery ticket prize of an amount that the Oregon State Lottery Commission does not allow a lottery game retailer to pay under ORS 461.250. the measure allows the Oregon State Lottery Commission to adopt rules necessary to enforce the provisions of section 2.
