WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure prohibits wagering on dog racing and removes references to dog racing in Oregon law. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 3020 prohibits wagering money or anything else of value, or accepting or facilitating a wager, on any kind of dog race regardless of where the race is taking place. It also prohibits Multi-Jurisdictional Simulcasting and Interactive Wagering Totalizator Hub Licensees from accepting or facilitating dog racing regardless of where the race takes place. The measure removes references to dog racing in Oregon law and repeals ORS 462.135 and ORS 462.279.
