## **Measure Description**

This measure provides a one-time General Fund appropriation totaling \$1 million in the 2025-27 biennium to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for distribution to Coos County and Curry County to transport veterans to the Roseburg Veterans Affairs Medical Center.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

The total fiscal impact of this measure is \$1 million General Fund for the 2025-27 biennium. The administrative costs for DAS to distribute these funds to the counties can be absorbed within current resources. Coos County and Curry County would each receive \$500,000.
