The measure updates the definition of a “licensee” as used in laws around alcoholic beverages to include agents appointed by the Oregon Cannabis and Liquor Commission (OLCC).

BACKGROUND:

House Bill 2121 updates the definition of a “licensee” as used in laws around alcoholic beverages to include agents appointed by the Oregon Cannabis and Liquor Commission (OLCC).

ORS 471.011 defines terms as used in ORS chapter 471 and 473. Currently, a “licensee” is defined as any person holding a license issued under the chapter. House Bill 2121 would also include agents appointed by the OLCC in this definition.
