**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Directs the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to study classification and compensation of forestry and wildland fire positions, addressing wage and management compression, identifying deficiencies in the Department of State Forestry, and providing recommendations. Directs DAS to submit findings to interim committees related to natural resources and wildfire no later than September 15, 2026.

Fiscal impact: May have fiscal impact, but no statement yet issued.

Revenue impact: May have revenue impact, but no statement yet issued.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Department of Forestry's (ODF) mission is to promote stewardship of Oregon's forests to enhance environmental, economic, and sustainability. ODF houses a range of field classifications, including Area and District Forest Managers, Forest Crew Coordinator and Lookouts, Forest Management Technician, two classes of Forest Manager, two classes of Forest Officer, Forest Nursery Worker, Technician, and Supervisors, Wildland Fire Dispatch Entry and Supervisor levels, and Wildland Fire Suppression Specialist Entry and Supervisor.
