**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Removes the limit on the maximum amount that a Child Advocacy Center (CAC) can receive from the CAC One-Time Grant Fund.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Oregon law requires the Department of Justice to administer the CAC One-Time Grant Fund, a noncompetitive grant program that expands access to services provided by children’s advocacy centers. Current law limits the total grant amount to \$300,000 per center, including associated healthcare providers or medical facilities. House Bill 3195 removes this funding cap.
