Re: Responses to Committee Questions on February 3, 2025

Dear Co-Chair Broadman and Co-Chair Evans:

Thank you for allowing us to present information on the current state of the unrepresented persons crisis Monday. I am writing today to provide additional information to questions asked by committee members.

1. Senator Broadman asked for a breakout of the average number of days a person is unrepresented in noncrisis counties as a trend over time.

The data shows that for nearly a year, March 2023 to March 2024, the noncrisis counties averaged a higher number of days persons were unrepresented by counsel than the crisis counties. Since April 2024, the crisis counties have steadily had a higher average number of days that defendants are unrepresented than the other counties.

In the last 10 months the average number of days in custody were greater for defendants in crisis counties than in noncrisis counties, while in the previous 12 months noncrisis counties had a higher average.

The chart below illustrates an average number of days defendants are unrepresented in the top six unrepresented counties (crisis counties) and in all other counties from September 2022 through January 2025, as a monthly average, to view the trends over time.

2. Representative Chotzen asked for information on the resolution method of cases in which defendants had attorneys appointed.

Although the monthly numbers vary, since July 2023 the most common resolution method was by plea negotiations, followed by participation in a pre-disposition program or specialty court, then dismissal, then trial.

Below, the chart illustrates the case outcomes, or disposition, of cases in which the defendant had been on the unrepresented list and subsequently received representation. The graph captures monthly data from July 2023 through January 2025. The chart stacks each case resolution type together by month for a visual representation of the proportions of cases resolved by pleas, trial, through specialty court or some other resolution, and by dismissal. It is important to note that this chart does not dig into the details to determine the number of dismissals generated through a "global resolution" where some cases are dismissed in exchange for a plea to charges in other cases.

As you can see, most of these cases are disposed by plea negotiation (48-65%), followed by dismissals (28-48%). A small number enter a specialty court or predisposition diversion program (3-9%), while a smaller percent result in trials (0-4%). Co-Chair Broadman and Co-Chair Evans Page 3 February 5, 2025



3. Senator Broadman asked if the Oregon Judicial Department (OJD) could identify the number of deputy district attorneys and attorneys in public defense practice in 2019.

OJD used a 2019 roster from the Oregon Criminal Defense Lawyers Association (OCDLA) and the Oregon Public Defense Commission (OPDC) contracts to identify 672 attorneys practicing public defense. We are not able to identify the corresponding number of prosecutors and would suggest the subcommittee ask the Oregon District Attorneys Association if it has helpful information.

In 2019, there were 672 contract attorneys (see attached OCDLA document). Attorneys are listed starting on page 90 of the document. We also have attached a spreadsheet with the data copied from the OCDLA document showing the attorneys by county, contract, and provider.

OPDC should be able to provide the current list of contract attorneys by county, contract, and provider, as well as the attorneys providing services under the Temporary Hourly Increase Program (THIP).
