

HB 3370 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY

WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

This measure changes the time allowed for state agencies to share information about a deceased person with financial institutions, allows a credit union's board of directors to delegate the duty to consider reinstatement to a credit union employee, and keeps the chair of the board of directors from serving on the board's supervisory committee. Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

HB 3370 changes the upper bound from 76 days to 75 days for a state agency to share the declaration required under section 3 of ORS 723.466. It allows a credit union's board of directors to delegate the duty to consider an expelled members request for reconsideration by an employee of the credit union. The measure also prohibits the chair of the board of directors of a credit union from sitting on the credit union's supervisory committee.
