## **1 Multi-Year Funding Commitments**

- Sustainable support for long-term success.

- Placing an emphasis on strong, well designed and long term local ecosystems where schools, CBOs, families and public agencies all have shared responsibility

## **3 Streamlined and Equitable Grant-making and Administration**

- Capacity Building for Smaller Organizations
- Dedicated State Infrastructure and Coordination

## **4 Streamlined Data Systems**

- Creating a unified approach to tracking outcomes and improving services.
- Setting clear standards and data driven practices
