BACKGROUND:

The <u>School-Age Speech and Language Clinic</u> at the University of Oregon's Speech-Language-Hearing Center provides evaluation and treatment to clients ages five to 21 in need of speech-language pathology services. The clinic operates a summer camp intended to improve social communication and interaction skills for its clients.
