BACKGROUND:

Senate Bill 1530 went into effect in 2024, appropriating \$258 million for the implementation of various state programs. The package included \$1,425,000 for the City of Madras and specified that the money was for stormwater infrastructure for The Heights at Yarrow Apartments and Belmont Lane Apartments. House Bill 2018 would expand the allowable use of this money to include public road improvements, utility connections, and sewer and water improvements.
