## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells RCFs to offer certain vaccines to residents. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Requires a residential care facility, including a facility with a memory care endorsement and an assisted living facility, to make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic per year.

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to vaccine clinics in residential care facilities.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 443.400 to 443.455.**

**SECTION 2. (1) From October 1 through March 1 of each year, a residential care facility, including a facility with a memory care endorsement under ORS 443.886 and an assisted living facility, shall make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic. The clinic shall administer vaccines for at least the following diseases:**

**(a) Influenza;**

**(b) COVID-19; and**

**(c) Pneumonia.**

**(2) A resident has a right, but is not required, to participate in a vaccine clinic.**
