SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells RCFs to offer certain vaccines to residents. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.3).

Requires a residential care facility, including a facility with a memory care endorsement and an assisted living facility, to make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic per year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to vaccine clinics in residential care facilities.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part

5 of ORS 443.400 to 443.455.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) From October 1 through March 1 of each year, a 7 residential care facility, including a facility with a memory care 8 endorsement under ORS 443.886 and an assisted living facility, shall 9 make available to residents at least one on-site vaccine clinic. The 10 clinic shall administer vaccines for at least the following diseases:

11 (a) Influenza;

12 (b) COVID-19; and

13 (c) Pneumonia.

(2) A resident has a right, but is not required, to participate in a
vaccine clinic.

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
