Measure Description

The measure appropriates \$1.5 million General Fund to the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) for deposit into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund to support activities that protect, maintain, or enhance fish and wildlife resources in Oregon, as well as other activities outlined in ORS 496.252(2).

Fiscal Analysis

ODFW receives a one-time appropriation of \$1.5 million General Fund for the 2025-27 biennium, to be deposited into the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund to be used for activities specified in ORS 496.252(2). Approximately \$1.4 million would be distributed through a competitive grant program with an estimated \$99,100 for administrative costs, including project planning and management, requests for proposals, technical reviews, and grant administration.

The Department will need an increase in Other Funds expenditure limitation to expend the moneys from the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund.
