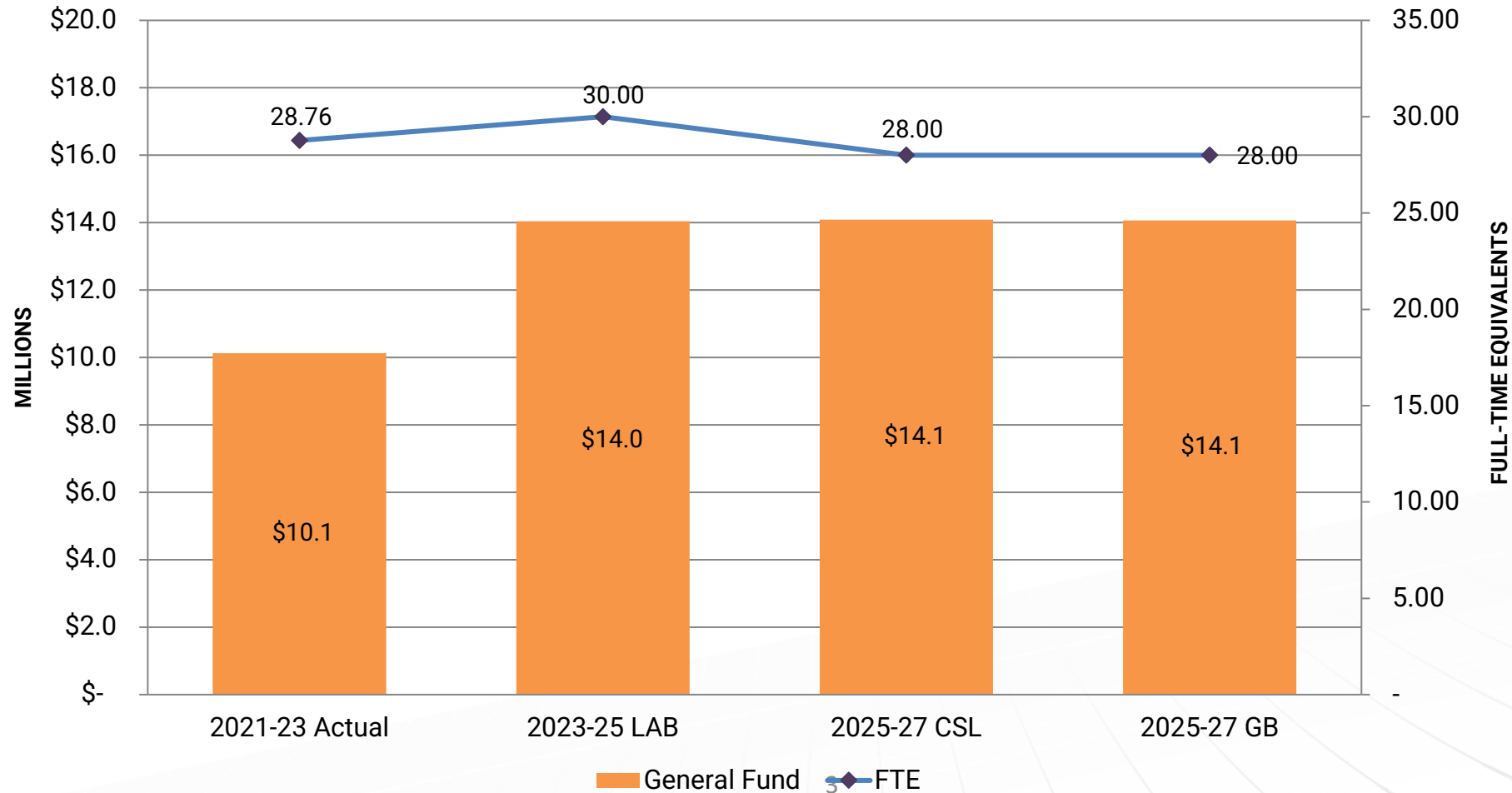
2025-27 Governor's Budget Overview

 - The Governor's Budget maintains agency operational funding
- Other Issues
 - Sex Offender Notification Level Program (SONL) will not meet its 2026 deadline for historical registrants
 - Steady increase in Attorney General costs

Expenditure History + 2025-27 Governor's Budget

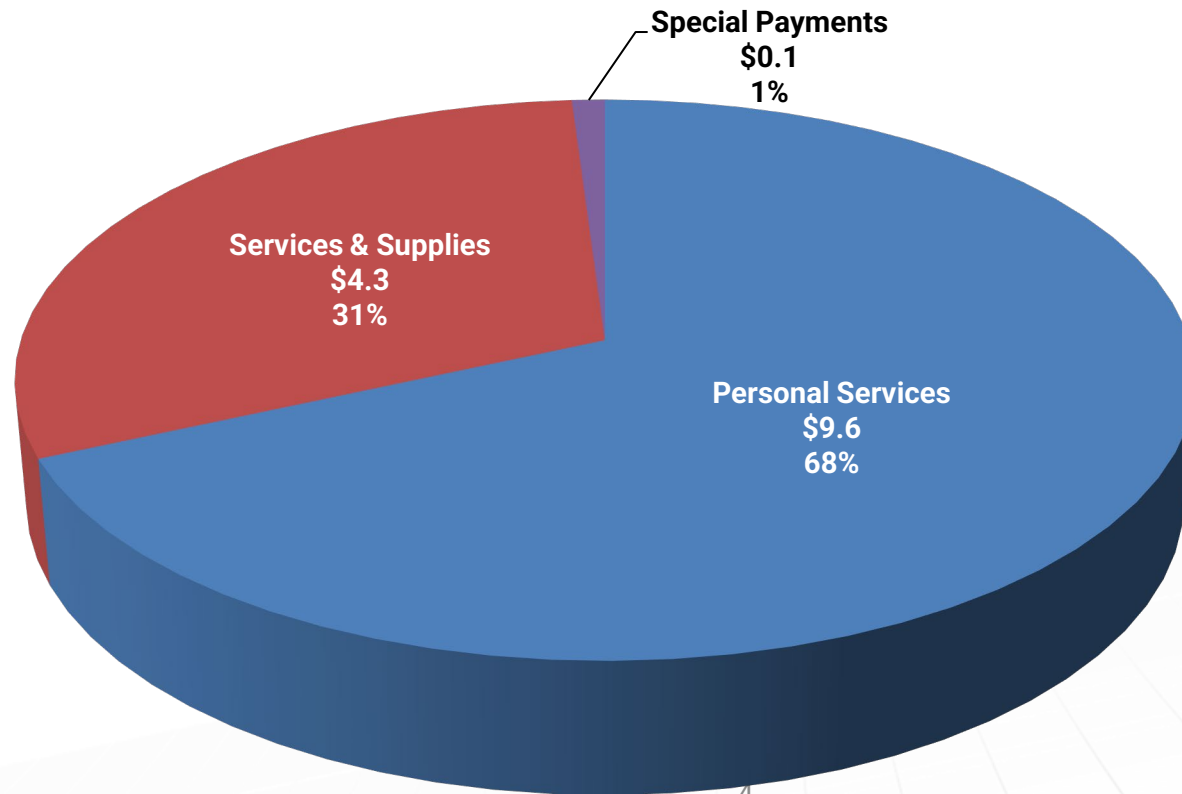

- The Governor's Budget invests in:
 - The Governor's Budget includes funding for the modernization of the Parole Board Management Information System (PBMIS).
- New issues since the Governor's Recommended Budget:
 - The Board has the opportunity to be included in the Department of Corrections Victim Information System in Oregon (VISOR).
 - Workload increase from a county exiting Morrissey Hearing agreement
