### **COMMISSION FOR WOMEN**

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Commission for Women subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### **New Appointee**

Jackie Wirz of Portland

#### Term

March 1, 2025 - February 28, 2029

### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 185.520 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

## Composition<sup>3</sup>

The commission has 11 Oregon residents:

- Nine at-large members (CHAPMAN, FORDE, HAUNSPERGER, KONEV, MERCIER, PARENT, RICO CORNWELL, SAECHAO, WIRZ);
- one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate (PATTERSON); and
- one Representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives (VACANT).

Governor appointees serve four-year terms; lawmakers serve two-year terms. The commission elects its chair and vice chair and must meet at least three times a year.

#### **Duties**<sup>4</sup>

The commission works for the implementation and establishment of economic, social, legal, and political equality for women and maintains a continuing assessment of the issues and needs confronting women in Oregon. The commission must

- submit a report to the Governor each biennium about the concerns and issues confronting women in Oregon and the programs, projects, and activities the commission will undertake to address them;
- analyze the legal status of women and men relating to civil rights, contracts, income, property, and the family to assure full equality and treatment;
- work for equal opportunity and treatment in employment by analyzing employment policies and practices;
- evaluate the development of methods to assure fuller employment options and examine methods to develop greater employment opportunities;
- evaluate the progress of providing equality of educational opportunities;
- inform women about nontraditional educational and employment opportunities;
- promote the elimination of sexist and racist barriers in the educational process;
- encourage women to pursue a variety of roles in life and promote the full recognition of their contributions;
- promote the value of work within the home and encourage women to serve on appointive boards and commissions and to seek elective office; and
- meet at least annually in a joint meeting of the Commission for Women, the Commission on Hispanic Affairs, the Commission on Black Affairs, and the Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs to consider and act upon issues of mutual importance.
