Not required.

Composition³

The commission consists of 11 Oregon residents who represent Asian and Pacific Islander (API) Americans:

- one Senator appointed by the President of the Senate (DEMBROW);
- one Representative appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives (VACANT); and
- nine members appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate (AKKARAJU, BULLING, DERTING, KIM, LEUNG, PHAN, RAJAGOPAL-DURBIN, TANEGA, TRAN).

Members serve four-year terms. The commission elects a chair and vice chair for one-year terms. A majority of members constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The commission works toward the implementation and establishment of economic, social, legal, and political equality for API Americans and assesses the issues and needs confronting them.

The commission must

- identify barriers to the economic development and trade opportunities of API Americans, and advise state agencies and officials on issues related to those barriers;
- establish an API Affairs Network;
- identify and examine the needs of API American residents;
- compile information relating to services available to API American residents;
- develop and sponsor programs in cooperation with API American groups and organizations to inform API American residents of services available to them;
- assess all state agencies' programs operating for the benefit of API American residents and make recommendations for improvement;
- serve as liaison to other state boards and commissions as required by law;
- submit a biennial report to the Governor describing API American needs and programs, projects, and activities that the commission will undertake; and
- meet at least annually in a joint meeting of the Commission on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs, the Commission on Hispanic Affairs, the Commission on Black Affairs, and the Commission for Women to consider and act upon issues of mutual importance to the missions and statutory duties of the commissions.
