LONG TERM CARE ADMINISTRATORS BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Long Term Care Administrators Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Statutory Requirements³

The board consists of nine residents concerned with the care of chronically ill or infirm elderly patients:

- three licensed nursing home administrators (COOK, CRISMON, HILTY);
- three licensed residential care facility administrators, at least one of whom serves in a memory care community (CLARK, LEWIS, PATEL);
- one licensed physician with expertise in geriatric care or care for persons with disabilities (MORGAN); and
- two public members, with one being at least 62 years of age (HANKINS, WEISS).

Appointees who represent the public must not be otherwise eligible for appointment and must not have familial relationships with a nursing home administrator or residential

care facility administrator. Appointees required to be nursing home administrators and residential care facility administrators may be chosen from a list of nominees submitted by any related professional organization. Certain conflicts of interest bar service, and not more than two members may be officials or full-time state or local government employees.

Appointees serve three-year terms and are eligible for reappointment. The board selects its chair and vice chair for one-year terms. A majority constitutes a quorum.

Duties⁴

The board advises the Health Licensing Office within the Oregon Health Authority on all matters concerning the regulation of nursing home and residential care facility administrators. Its duties include advising on standards for licensure, education and training, professional conduct and practice, and sanctions; conducting exams for license applicants; and providing other advice and regulatory assistance. The board may also establish reciprocal licensing standards.
