The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Portland subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Required.

Composition³

The board consists of nine U.S. citizens and Oregon residents, with not fewer than two from each county constituting the port district:

- Clackamas County (LAM, STRADER);
- Multnomah County (ADAMS, DEVAUGHN, JOHNSON, NIEMI);
- Washington County (LUTHER, SAMPAT); and
- Other Counties outside the port district (COBA).

Commissioners must have resided within the state for one year immediately preceding appointment. They serve four-year terms and may be removed for malfeasance after a hearing and upon determination of the Multnomah County Circuit Court.

The board must hold at least one meeting each month. The Governor designates the president of the board, who must designate a vice president, treasurer, and secretary.

Duties⁴

The board sets policy for the operation of the Port of Portland. The board must

- oversee the finances of the port, including the issuance and sale of revenue bonds and the approval of contracts for work and materials;
- · determine the fair value of property acquired by the port; and
- provide assessment of the damages and benefits of the filling or reclamation of any low, swamp, or submersible land as contemplated by the port.
