OREGON STATE BOARD OF NURSING

The Governor has appointed the following individuals to the Oregon State Board of Nursing subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Composition³

The board consists of nine Oregon residents:4

- five registered nurses:
 - one nursing educator (MCKINLEY YODER);
 - one nursing administrator (STANICH);
 - two nonsupervisory nurses involved in direct patient care (MITZEL, TOWOBOLA); and
 - o one nurse practitioner (COOKSEY);
- one licensed practical nurse (NESTA);
- one certified nursing assistant (DENNIS); and
- two public members who are otherwise not eligible for appointment (HILL, KALIS).

Members serve three-year terms. The board elects annually a president, presidentelect, and a secretary. The nurses may be selected from a list of nominees from related professional organizations. They must be currently licensed, in good standing, and have at least five years' experience, three of which were immediately prior to appointment. Public members and any person who is a spouse, domestic partner, child, parent, or sibling of a public member may not be licensed by the board.

Duties⁵

The board regulates the practice of nursing. The board must

- exercise general supervision over the practice of nursing in this state;
- administer licensing, including setting applicant qualifications and curriculum and training standards, and approving nurse education programs, examinations, and scope of practice;
- adopt a seal and necessary rules;
- keep a record of proceedings, licensed persons, and approved schools or programs;
- enforce the related provisions and incur necessary expenses;
- enter into specified interagency agreements;
- keep a record of all moneys deposited in the Oregon State Board of Nursing Account; and
- upon receipt of a complaint, conduct an investigation.
