# STATE WORKFORCE AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the State Workforce and Talent Development Board subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

#### Reappointee

Steve Johnson of Lake Oswego

#### Term

March 1, 2025 - February 28, 2028

#### **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 660.321 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

## **Composition**<sup>3</sup>

The federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act<sup>4</sup> requires the governor of each state to establish a state workforce development board. Membership must include

- the Governor, or designee (FICHT, PORTER);
- a member of each chamber of the state legislature appointed by each presiding officer, nonvoting (DEMBROW, PHAM); and,
- members appointed by the Governor, who represent:
  - businesses (BOZINOVIC, CAMPBELL, CREMONA WAGNER, DUNN, HOPEWELL, JOHNSON, LATIMER, LEWIS, MADDEN, MERSEREAU, NAGASUBRAMANIAN, NEWBERRY, PALIWAL, POOL, POPKIN, PRICHARD, RADIE, REDDY, REYNOLDS, VENKATRAMAN, WIRZ);
  - $\circ$  the workforce (BURGER, FRIEDMAN, NEHLS);
  - the government (CANNON, DRUGGE, GERSTENFELD, GUPTA, HUNT, LOPEZ, OZOLS, POPE, SCHRADER); and
  - o ther interested groups (BENNINGS, BITTON, FRAZIER, REIBACH, REIMAN).

Business members must be the majority of membership; workforce members must be at least 20 percent of membership; and there must one representative of a local workforce development board. The Governor selects a business representative to serve as chair.

#### **Duties**

The federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act is designed to strengthen and improve the nation's public workforce system.<sup>5</sup> It requires each state workforce development board to assist the governor and <sup>6</sup>

- develop, implement, and modify a workforce development plan, support a comprehensive workforce development system, and prepare annual reports;
- identify and disseminate information about best practices;
- develop, review, and improve policies for the coordinated provision of services;
- develop formulas for the distribution of funds for employment and training;
- develop a workforce and labor market information system and a statewide employment statistics system;
- ensure timely consultation with government and workforce stakeholders;
- review and approve local workforce plans; and
- recommend responsibilities for state agencies to implement the federal Act.

The board must

- make available to the public information regarding the activities of the board;
- establish objective qualifications for the director;
- identify key industries and workforce skills needed for them to grow and thrive;
- identify needs for education, training, work experience, and job preparation;
- identify opportunities for partnerships with key industry sectors;
- provide guidance to local workforce development boards;
- function as the primary advisory committee to the Employment Department;
- work with the Oregon Business Development Commission;
- hold state workforce agencies and local workforce development boards accountable for meeting performance goals and system outcomes;
- determine needs across key industries for talent pipeline infrastructure; and
- each biennium, publish a state Workforce and Talent Development Plan.
