
Public Employees Retirement System 2025-27 Governor's Budget Investments



Approved Policy Packages:


- Core Retirement System Applications Division: Modernization \$34 million
- Central Administration Division: Staff to support human resources, enterprise content management, and communications staffing - \$0.9 million
- Information Services Division: ORION technical updates, SB 1049 (2019) resources, ISD dues and subscriptions, information services division re-classes - \$5.0 million
- Operations Division: HB 4045 (2024), SB 1049 (2019) resources, operations staffing \$2.5 million
- Compliance, Audit, and Risk Division: ISD dues and subscriptions, risk management, policy and compliance staffing- \$3.2 million
