WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Expands eligibility for the Address Confidentiality Program to include victims of child abduction.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Address Confidentiality Program, administered by the Department of Justice, provides a substitute address to protect the location of individuals at risk, such as victims of domestic violence, stalking, and human trafficking. Current law does not explicitly include victims of child abduction. House Bill 2710 would expand the program to cover these victims.
