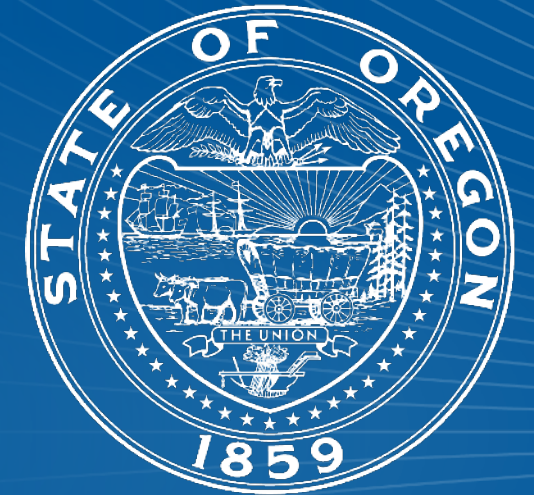

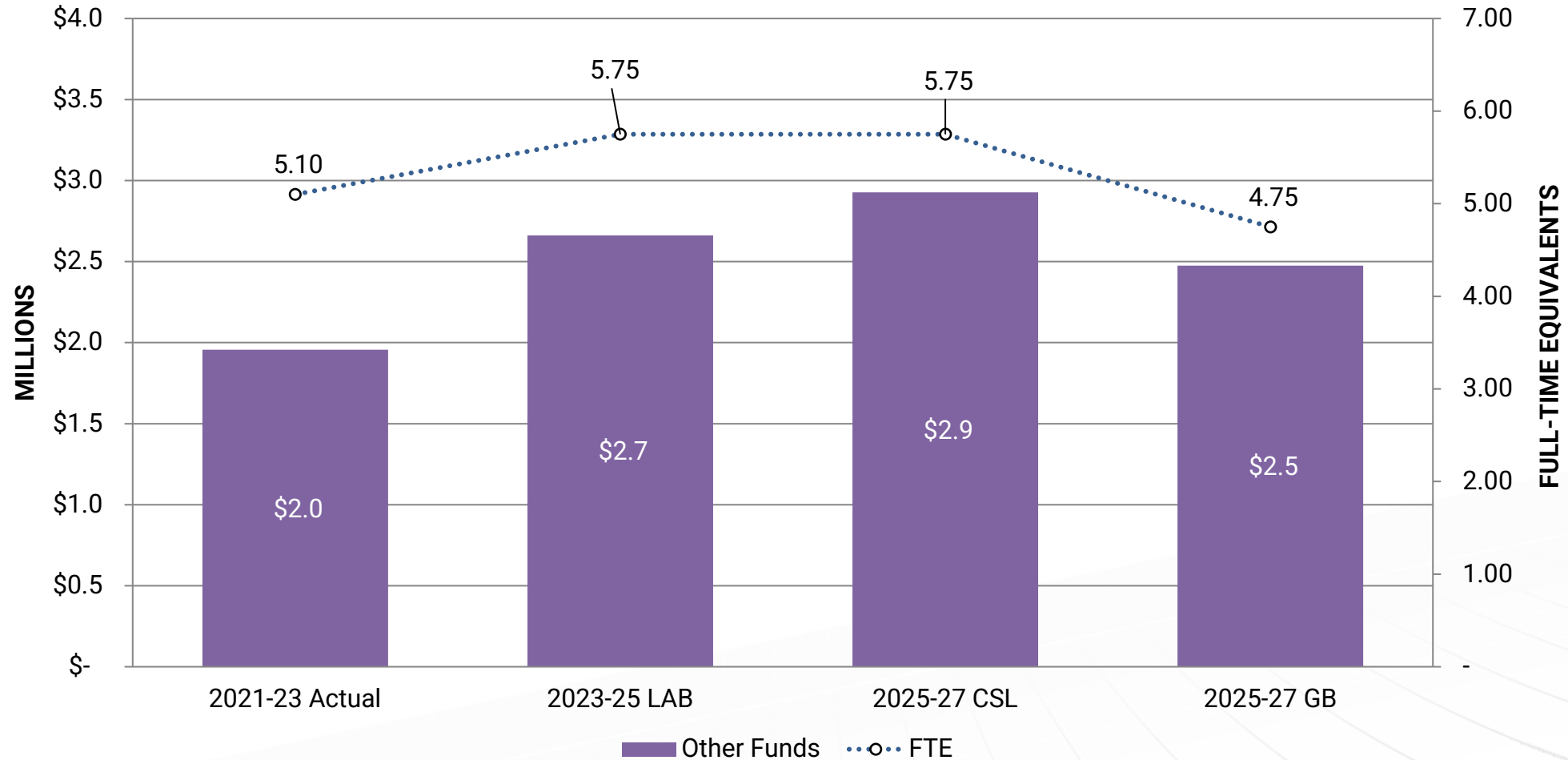
2025-27 Governor's Budget Overview



- Emerging Issues
 - Revenue Shortfall
 - Fee Ratification
- To align with projected revenues, the Governor's budget makes reductions from the current service level by reducing Services and Supplies and eliminating one investigative position.
 - Includes revenues from fee increases in the current biennium.

Expenditure History + 2025-27 Governor's Budget

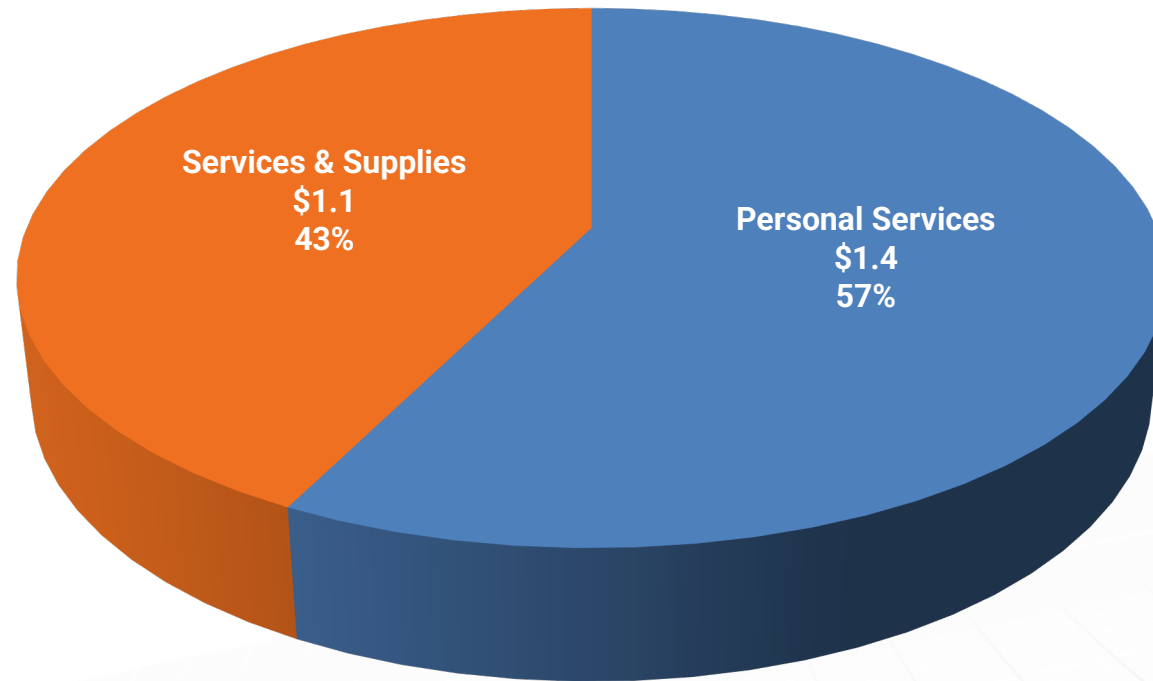

Revenue Sources



- Other Funded Agency
 - Licenses applications, renewals, and examinations
 - Renewals take place annually on licensee's birthday
 - Civil penalties, examination retakes, and miscellaneous
- Fee Ratification
 - 30 percent fee increase implemented in current biennium, with a higher increase on initial Doctor of Chiropractic applications
 - Increases in 2023 and 2024
