WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure eliminates permit-entry closure on forestland due to fire danger.

- Differences between permit types
- Oregon Department of Forestry closure processes

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Currently, there are three types of closures a forester may proclaim for forestland subject to restricted uses if a forest protection district is particularly exposed to fire danger:

- 1. Regulated closure,
- 2. Permit closure, or
- 3. Absolute closure (Oregon Revised Statute 477.535).
