# WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates general funds to the Department of Justice to offset reductions in funding from federal Victims of Crime Act grants. Declares an emergency, effective on passage.

Revenue: No impact Fiscal: Fiscal impact issued

#### **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

Reasoning for the increase in need

Education on consent and healthy relationships to address need

Prevention of sexual assault cases

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

-1 The amendment adds \$18,500,000 as the amount to be appropriated to the DOJ to offset reductions of VACA grants. Further, it appropriates \$3,000,000 to the DOJ for the Oregon CASA Network.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) provides federal funding for victim assistance and compensation programs. VOCA grants have been reduced in recent years. The state's General Fund does not currently supplement VOCA grants funding for these programs. House Bill 3196 appropriates general funds to the Department of Justice (DOJ) to offset reductions in federal VOCA funding and includes an emergency clause for immediate implementation.
