SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says that a person who is a court visitor is not liable for injuries that happen when the person is doing the things the court said to do. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.4).

Grants court visitors immunity from liability when acting in good faith and within the scope of the visitor's duties.

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part

5 of ORS chapter 25.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> A person appointed as a court visitor is immune from 7 any liability for acts, omissions or errors in judgment, if the act, 8 omission or error in judgment is made in good faith and within the 9 scope of the person's duties, responsibilities or functions as a court 10 visitor.
