1687	02/17/2025	Requires the Department of Corrections to implement a list of policies for adults in custody, including policies related to gender-responsive, evidence based and trauma-informed practices at the Coffee Creek Correctional Facility.
1690	10/30/2024	Creates the crime of unlawful disclosure of private information. Punishes by a maximum of six months' imprisonment, \$2,500 fine, or both
4049	02/18/2025	Provides that the sex offender risk assessment methodology used to classify sex offenders into risk levels may exclusively consider a sex offender's risk of reoffending at the time of release, sentencing or discharge. Authorizes a classifying entity to reassess or reclassify a person after the commission of a new sexually motivated act or sex crime.
4287	01/28/2025	Grants court visitors' immunity from liability when acting in good faith and within the scope of the visitor's duties.

4357	02/05/2025	Expands the crime of assault in the third degree to include assault of a public transit vehicle operator performing official duties. Expands the crime of aggravated harassment to include knowing propulsion of bodily fluids at a public transit vehicle operator performing official duties. Punishes by a maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.
4553	01/23/2025	Modifies the felony of causing death or serious physical injury using an unmanned aircraft system to include causing death or serious physical injury by causing an unmanned aircraft system to interfere with a wildfire suppression, law enforcement or emergency response effort.
