



Breaking the Cycle

The Data Driven Way to **Reduce Adult Homelessness**

ODHS Youth Experiencing Houselessness Program (YEHP):

- ODHS Program funds housing and supports for YEH
- HB 3079 and a parallel budget request would:
 - Increase the number of youth served statewide by YEHP, including by expanding the program into more parts of the state
 - Fund workforce development and behavioral health services for youth

OHCS Youth Experiencing Houselessness Assistance Program (YEHA):

- Prevention program for families with kids, K through grade 12, at risk of houselessness
- Provides services like emergency rental and utility assistance, paying rental application fees
- HB 3079 would expand eligibility to include families with preschool-aged kids
- A parallel budget request would increase this prevention funding from \$5m to \$15m

Kids Programs: A Decade of Disinvestment

2011 - - Local "Children & Families Commissions" Eliminated

2009 - 15 - - Budget Cuts to:


Homeless Youth
MH / BH Programs
Foster Care
Child Welfare

By 2019:

- 67% <u>cut</u> in children's residential programs,
- 90% cut to homeless youth programs,
- √ 90%+ <u>cut</u> to substance abuse treatment for children.

Result:

- ✓ Oregon is now 46th in youth mental health
- ✓ 21,000+ homeless <u>adults</u> (who came from...)

Math:

400+ aging out of services each year

9 years
$$X 400 = 3,600$$

42.5% of UH are 25-44

Total UH Ages 25-44* = 3,549
