SUMMARY

Digest: Tells DCBS to create and make rules about a Uniform Rate Program. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.8).

Requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish a Uniform Rate Program. Requires the department to adopt rules for this program according to certain requirements.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Uniform Rate Program.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2025 Act is added to and made a part

5 of the Insurance Code.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A Uniform Rate Program is established in the De-7 partment of Consumer and Business Services. The purpose of the 8 program is to establish a uniform fee and rate schedule for all insurers 9 offering an individual or small employer group health benefit plan in 10 this state.

11 (2) The department shall establish for the program:

(a) A premium rate that is based on a set of benefits as determined
by the department but including, at a minimum, the essential health
benefits described in ORS 731.097.

(b) A uniform reimbursement rate established by the department
for all services provided by a health care provider as defined in ORS
192.556 that is based on:

(A) A percentage, not to exceed 200 percent, of the Medicare pay ment for the same service; and

1 (B) The rate at which the service is expected to be utilized.

2 (c) A cap on administrative fees established by the department that
3 can be billed by insurers.

4 (d) An annual increase in reimbursement rates established by the 5 department that does not exceed 3.5 percent in a three-year period.

6 (e) An annual increase in premiums established by the department
7 that does not exceed 6.5 percent in a three-year period.

8 (3) The department shall adopt rules to carry out the requirements
9 of this section.

10 <u>SECTION 3.</u> The Department of Consumer and Business Services 11 may apply for a waiver for state innovation under 42 U.S.C. 18052 to 12 carry out the requirements of section 2 of this 2025 Act.

<u>SECTION 4.</u> Sections 1 to 3 of this 2025 Act become operative on
 January 1, 2027.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> The Department of Consumer and Business Services may take any action before the operative date specified in section 4 of this 2025 Act that is necessary for the department to exercise, on or after the operative date specified in section 4 of this 2025 Act, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by sections 1 to 3 of this 2025 Act.
