WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development to study issues regarding siting of energy facilities in designated critical groundwater areas and to report its findings to an appropriate interim committee of the legislature by September 15, 2026.

BACKGROUND:

Critical groundwater area (CGA) is a statutory designation that allows the Water Resources Commission, in rule, to not only limit the issuance of new groundwater rights, but also impose a range of restrictions on existing ground water rights. Oregon currently has seven CGAs.
